**Stableford Scoring (NET)**  
 A twist on the American handicap system. We're going overseas today - scoring the way they do it back in the Old Sod, Stableford style.

In this game it's not where you end up - it's how you got there. **Net** Birdies and Eagles are worth far more than lowly Pars and Bogies. And doubles - forget 'em. Not worth a point. If you shoot your handicap on every hole to post a net even par round - congratulations, that's worth 36 points. But shoot the exact same total with 9 birds and 9 bogies - that's worth 63 points. It's not about what you shoot - it's how you shot it.

**Play full handicap. Net score on each hole worth points:**  
 Doubles or worse = 0  
 Bogies = 1 point  
 Pars = 2 points  
 Birdies = 4 points  
 Eagles = 8 points

Don't worry if you can't add them all up - that's what computers are for. Your job is to aim for the pin and put those puts in the back of the cup.
