As you'll see the front nine are even rankings; odds on the back
Most holes move one or two notches. Although there were more significant shifts:

Biggest changes in "Saxony Grill Survey" are

- #16 - that diabolical par 3 was NEVER the second easiest hole on the course. It moves from #17 to #7.
- #9 - a relatively benign par 4 that really doesn't bite as hard as its original ranking implied. It moves from 6th most difficult to 4th easiest.
- #6 - our new nemeses climbs from 14 to 8 (and on my card it could keep going even higher).
- #2 (ranked as a par 4) plays relatively easy and moves down 4 places.
- #7 - now an uphill challenge at many people's limit - rises from 2nd easiest to 12th most difficult.

Think about your scores and which holes you are most likely to par/birdie or bogie/double.
In fact the key is in the birdies and doubles - where are your biggest numbers - where are your best chances for a good score?
