Local Rules

1,

When a player's ball has not been found or is known or virtually certain to be out of bounds, the player may proceed as follows rather than proceeding under stroke and distance.

For two penalty strokes, the player may take relief by dropping the original ball or another ball in this relief area (see Rule 14.3):

Two Estimated Reference Points:

a. Ball Reference Point: The point where the original ball is estimated to have:

- 1. Come to rest on the course, or
- 2. Last crossed the edge of the course boundary to go out of bounds.

b. Fairway Reference Point: The point of fairway of the hole being played that is nearest to the ball reference point, but is not nearer the hole than the ball reference point.

For purposes of this Local Rule, "fairway" means any area of grass in the general area that is cut to fairway height or less.

If a ball is estimated to be lost on the course or last crossed the edge of the course boundary short of the fairway, the fairway reference point may be a grass path or a teeing ground for the hole being played cut to fairway height or less.

Size of Relief Area Based on Reference Points: Anywhere between:

1.A line from the hole through the ball reference point (and within two club-lengths to the outside of that line), and

2.A line from the hole through the fairway reference point (and within two club-lengths to the fairway side of that line).

But with these limits:

Limits on Location of Relief Area:

Must be in the general area, and

Must not be nearer the hole than the ball reference point.

Once the player puts a ball in play under this Local Rule:

The original ball that was lost or out of bounds is no longer in play and must not be played.

This is true even if the ball is found on the course before the end of the three-minute search time

But, the player may not use this option to take relief for the original ball when:

That ball is known or virtually certain to have come to rest in a penalty area, or The player has played another ball provisionally under penalty of stroke and distance (see Rule 18.3). A player may use this option to take relief for a provisional ball that has not been found or is known or virtually certain to be out of bounds.

Boundaries, Hazards, and Immoveable Obstructions

1.

Out of Bounds

The following are out of bounds: parking lot, maintenance area, fence at left of hole from the wooded area to 2 teeing area

2.

Out of Bounds

The fence on the left side of the hole and then the sunken old bridle path on th left side of the fairway, and the maintenance area past 3 tee

3.

Hazards

Red Penalty areas

The entire wooded area on the let side of the hole until the creek, the wooded area left of 3 hole and beyond 3 hole, the entire wooded area on the right side of the hole until the creek; the wooded area behind and to the right of the green; and the creek after it turns left towards 8 hole

Yellow Penalty areas

The area in front of the creek from the woods to the right turn.

Immoveable Obstruction

The french drain behind the green

4.

Red Penalty Areas

The wooded areas to the left and right of the hole

5.

Out of Bounds

The area to the left of the teeing area and extending to the fence on the left side of the hole; the wooded area as it runs along the left side of the hole until the fence nce at the top of the mound; and , the fence of the left side; and, the inside edge of the rocks along the until the wooded area to the left of 5 teeing area

6.

Red Penalty Areas

The wooded areas to the left of the hole; the wooded area behind the green; the wooded areas to the right of the hole; the area to the right of the hole as it ascends the hill; and the "pond" to the right of the fairway

7.Red Penalty Areas

The wooded area to the left of the hold extending until the stone wall; the area to the left of the stone wall, the inside edge of the stone wall marking the beginning of the red penalty area; the wooded area behind and to the right of the green

8.

Red Penalty Areas

The entire wooded area on the right of the hole except for the area of the creek and the creek on the left side of the hole.

Yellow Penalty Area

The creek on the right side of the hole

10.

Red Penalty Area

The pond/creek to the left side of the fairway; and the entire creek behind 11 teeing area

11.

Yellow Penalty Area

The creek in front of the teeing area extending to 17 Hole

Immovable Obstructions

The drainage ditch of the left side of 11 green

12

Yellow Penalty Area

The creek behind the green bordering 8 fairway

13.

Red Penalty Area

The entire length of the creek on the left side until the bridge on the left

Yellow Penalty Area

The entire length of the creek from the left bridge to the wooded area on the left side of 14

14.

Red Penalty Area

The wooded area from the teeing area to the creek; the entire length of the creek on the left side of the hole; and, the creek on the left side of 13 Hole from the bridge back 13 tee.

Yellow Penalty Area

The creek from the wooded area to the left of the fairway to the far bridge on 13 Hole

Immovable Obstruction

The fence at the back of 15 tee is an immoveable from which interference with stance or swing is permitted. There is no line of sight relief without penalty.

15.

Red Penalty Area

The creek along the left side of the Hole, the wooded area on the left side of the Hole after

the creek disappears, the wooded area to the right and in front of the teeing area, and the wooded area behind the green

16.

Red Penalty Areas

The wooded area to the right of the fairway extending to the creek; the wooded area from the far side of the creek to infinity; and ,the wooded areas on the right from the teeing area to the creek.

Yellow Penalty Areas

The creek from the woods on the right to the far bridge on 11 Hole

17.

Red Penalty Areas

The wooded areas from the teeing areas to the creek behind and to the right of the green and the creek running from 16 Hole to 18 Tee

18.

Out of bounds

The area bounded by the path on the entire length of the hole. The inside edge of the path. marks the boundary.

Immovable Obstruction

The cart barn is an immoveable obstruction from which interference with stance or swing is permitted.
